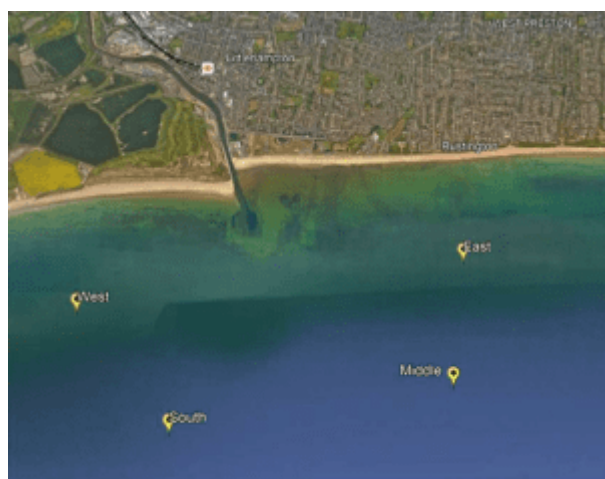

## RACE MARKS OFF LITTLEHAMPTON

**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** that the four yellow Special Marks established off Littlehampton by the Arun Yacht Club for yacht racing purposes are now on station year-round rather than seasonal as previously. Going forward, they will only be ashore in pairs for short servicing periods of circa 3 weeks over the winter months.

<b>West</b>	50° 47.40N 000°33.62W	Yellow, 1m diam. 'X' topmark Flashing Yellow every 5 sec (Fl.Y.5s)	1.5 NM 250°T



Mariners are also advised that the licensed positions have been adjusted multiple times in recent years to facilitate shorter and therefore more inclusive courses for amateur crews and/or slower

yachts.
